Dear St. Joseph Families,

Our patron saint, St. Joseph has two feast days. We remember Joseph as the foster father of Jesus on March 19th and on May 1st we remember St Joseph the worker. Joseph understood the importance of work. He was a carpenter—a builder—and probably taught Jesus his trade. Through his work, Joseph honored the Father in heaven and continued the act of creation. He lived in dignity and is a model for us of the dignity of all work.

To give workers a patron, the Church turned to Joseph, who had been made the Patron of the Universal Church by Pope Pius IX in 1870 and the model for fathers of families. Joseph was named protector of workers by Pope Benedict XV, and in 1955, the feast of Saint Joseph the Worker on May 1 was proclaimed by Pius the XII.

Especially in this difficult time in our world, let us pray to Saint Joseph for his help in all our work and for those many people who want and need jobs.

As we move through these uncertain time, we want you to know we think of you and miss your children every day.




A flyer from Peter Piper Pizza with a coloring page for kids and a coupon for a free pizza.
