Dear St. Joseph Families,

The most important job of our teachers is to teach! Seems obvious but our teachers have so many other tasks that take their attention. Here are some tips to help our amazing teachers keep their focus on teaching:

If you need to get ahold of a teacher with information that isn't urgent, please email the teacher directly rather than calling the front office. Urgent messages, of course please call the front office.

If your child is going to be absent, please call and let us know. You may call the office at any time and leave a voice message with the date and your child's name and their teacher. This will help us with attendance.

If you need to have your child leave early, please let us know ahead of time. This will allow the teacher to have your child ready with any work they might miss.

Homework requests must be made no later than 11 AM and will be ready for pick up at 3:20 (or 12:20 on Friday). Please call the front office and make the request or leave a voice message on the front office number with your child's name and grade. Homework requests made after 11 are not guaranteed to be ready by 3:20. Please call the office and check before making a special trip to pick up work.
