THANK YOU TO ALL FAMILIES WHO ARE HAVING THEIR CHILD BRING THEIR CELL PHONE TO THE MAIN OFFICE AS PER THE HANDBOOK POLICY. WE APPRECIATE YOUR SUPPORT!

Cell phones— Students are not permitted to bring any electronic equipment, especially cell phones and other devices which connect to wifi, to school. If a student does, however, bring electronic devices or a cell phone to school, **student must bring the device to the main office and check it in.** The device will be returned at dismissal or from ESD or sports. **Any student using a cell phone on campus will be required to surrender the phone.** It may then be picked up at the end of the school day from the main office by the adult picking up the student. If a student needs to make a call during the day, he/she must request permission to use a school phone.

Any teacher / school staff member has the authority and responsibility to confiscate any electronic device heard or seen during school hours and the device will be turned into the Principal. It is expressly forbidden and a violation of teachers' rights to record or photograph, make any audio or video recording, or download any pictures or video of teachers without written permission of those teachers for each instance. Any examples of photos, videos or audio recordings of teachers will result in the student(s) facing disciplinary measures as it is a direct violation of St Joseph Catholic School code and may be reported to local officials.
