In the words of Pope Francis

- Fast from hurting words and say kind words.
- Fast from sadness and be filled with gratitude.
- Fast from anger and be filled with patience.
- · Fast from pessimism and be filled with hope.

- Fast from complaints and contemplate simplicity.
- Fast from pressures and be prayerful.
- Fast from bitterness and fill your hearts with joy.

The three traditional pillars of **Lent** are prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Through the three pillars of Lent we journey to develop a closer relationship to God.

Beginning with Ash Wed, Feb. 14, we would like the students to practice almsgiving by bringing loose change for the collection.

Beginning Feb. 16 we will pray the Stations of the Cross at 8:30 every Friday in Lent. This will be followed by Adoration for the older grades. **The office will be closed during the Stations of the Cross**. Please join us.
