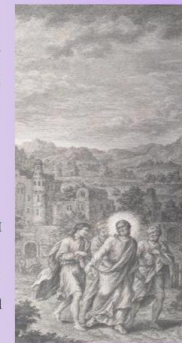
Lenten Mission March 12th-14th

Seeking to introspect 'with the Lord' the humble disciples in the evening of their spiritual day, earned the gift of this invitation by subsequently seeing Him in the Breaking of the Bread.
