**Lenten Regulations** Abstinence from eating any meat is observed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all the Fri days of Lent by Catholics 14 years of age and older. Fasting, one full meal with two lighter meals allowed if necessary, observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by Catholics ages 18-59.

*Excerpt from the message of His holiness Pope Francis for Lent*

*“Let us not grow tired of doing good, for in due time we shall reap our harvest, if we do not give up. So then, while we have the opportunity, let us do good to all” (Gal 6:9-10)*

**“...Each year during Lent we are reminded that goodness, together with love, justice and solidarity, are not achieved once and for all; they have to be realized each day. Let us ask God to give us the patient perseverance of the farmer, and to persevere in doing good, one step at a time. If we fall, let us stretch out our hand to the Father, who always lifts us up. If we are lost, if we are misled by the enticements of the evil one, let us not hesitate to return to God, who is generous in forgiving. In this season of conversion, sustained by God's grace and by the communion of the Church, let us not grow tired of doing good. The soil is prepared by fasting, watered by prayer and enriched by charity. Let us believe firmly that if we do not give up, we shall reap our harvest in due time and that, with the gift of perseverance, we shall obtain what was promised for our salvation and the salvation of others. By cultivating fraternal love towards everyone, we are united to Christ, who gave his life for ours, and we are granted a foretaste of the joy of the kingdom of heaven, when God will be all in all.”**
